# A Perfect Law for an Imperfect man?

Has the definition of sin changed since Adam sinned and Moses received the “Ten Commandments”?

“God’s Word” the “Ten Commandments” were written by God himself and given to Moses on tablets of stone!

## Exd 33:18 - 20

Moses said to God, “I beseech thee, shew me thy glory”.

And God said, I will make all my goodness pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before thee; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy.

And God said, Thou canst not see my face: for there shall no man see me, and live.

God revealed his Righteousness to Moses and his people and gave Moses the “Word of God revealing God’s Righteousness” on the tablets of stone.

This was the wedding invitation given by God to Moses for those who would prepare themselves for the groom’s coming. Which was Jesus Christ “God’s Word” made flesh.

## Rom 11:22

Behold therefore the goodness and severity of God: on them which fell, severity; but toward thee, goodness, if thou continue in [his] goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off.

## Hbr 8:10

For this [is] the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:

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### **Exd. 13:9**

And it shall be for a sign unto thee **upon thine hand, and for a memorial between thine eyes**, that the LORD'S law may be in thy mouth: for with a strong hand hath the LORD brought thee out of Egypt.

### **Deu 6:10 - 12**

And it shall be, when the LORD thy God shall have brought thee into the land which he sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give thee great and goodly cities, which thou buildedst not,

And houses full of all good [things], which thou filledst not, and wells digged, which thou diggedst not, vineyards and olive trees, which thou plantedst not; when thou shalt have eaten and be full;

[Then] beware lest thou forget the LORD, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.

### **Deu 6:17-18**

Ye shall diligently **keep the commandments of the LORD your God**, and his testimonies, and his statutes, which he hath commanded thee.

And thou shalt do [that which is] **right and good in the sight of the LORD**: that it may be well with thee, and that thou mayest go in and possess the good land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers,

### **Deu 11:22 - 28**

For if **ye shall diligently keep all these commandments** which I command you, to do them, to love the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, and to cleave unto him;

Then will the LORD drive out all these nations from before you, and ye shall possess greater nations and mightier than yourselves.

Every place whereon the soles of your feet shall tread shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the river Euphrates, even unto the uttermost sea shall your coast be.

There shall no man be able to stand before you: [for] the LORD your God shall lay the fear of you and the dread of you upon all the land that ye shall tread upon, as he hath said unto you.

Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse;

A blessing, if ye obey the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day:

And a curse, if ye will not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which ye have not known.

My mother once became disturbed by us kids because we were tracking dirt and leaves into the house. Mom kept her house very clean and pristine. Any dirt wrinkled rugs etc just would not go uncorrected.

When she became weary of telling us how she wanted us to respect her house and keep the house clean she would only allow us to enter the house through the back door. She put a note on the front door to enter at the back door.

At the back door there was another note which read: Take your shoes off at the door. Please!

This was rather inconvenient a first for us but it made mother happy. The house now was easier to keep clean and pristine the way Mom liked it to be.

After a few days the whole family had memorized the note and had become accustomed to the new laws and we never gave it another thought because they were in our minds and hearts and we lived by them to avoid the consequences of disobedience.

Eventually the notes became worn and were removed the law did not have to be posted any longer because we knew the rules of the house.

When somebody knocked or attempted to enter the front door we knew they were either a stranger such as a salesman or someone who did not know the rules at our house.

Because they were not of our household they unknowingly attempted to break the house rules.

We understood why the rule existed but others who we would tell to come around to the back door would sometimes be offended and grumble as if we were putting them to some great trouble.

When the Note was put back on the door even the stranger who was not of our household obeyed the Law!

Did mother's rule change because the note was not on the door anymore?

No. The rule was still in power because it was in our minds and our hearts to please our Mom by doing the things she had asked us to do.

The "Ten Commandments" are also to be in the hearts of God's people. If we are not following the Law's or Rules of God's Kingdom then it may be that we do not know the King of Righteousness.

### **Mat 7:22 - 23**

Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

Because Jesus Christ has come in the flesh, man will walk in Righteousness and keep the "Laws of God" in his heart. He will not transgress the "Commandments of God" as others did of old.

Those transgressors being weak and blind to God's Righteousness did not resist the lusts of sin and disobedience and they transgressed against "God's Word".

Are there now rewards for those who willingly violate the "Ten Commandments" where in the past others died under the penalty of death for sin?

Didn't Adam, being a "Righteous Man" created in the "Image of God" and having the breath of life from God, and being a partaker of God's Righteousness, suffer the "death of sin" when he violated "God's Word" because he disobeyed the "Commandment" of God; Thou shalt not eat of the tree in the midst of the garden?

### **Rom 3:31**

Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the law.

Do we now make void the “Ten Commandments” through faith? God forbid: yes, we establish the “The Commandments in our hearts”.

The “Ten Commandments” are the marriage vows of the bride and Groom those who are of the “Household of God” and “God’s Kingdom”. These are given that those who are redeemed may know how to represent themselves without dishonoring God. Such as the bride seeks to do those things that bring honor to her husband’s name that he may be please with her and proud to be identified as being one with her.

### 1Cr 7:39

The wife is bound by the law as long as her husband liveth; but if her husband be dead, she is at liberty to be married to whom she will; only in the Lord.

Is God dead? No it was mankind that became a harlot and committed Adultery against the “Father of Righteousness” with the “father of sin”!

Subject of Study:

A. The two covenants, one promise under the “Two Covenants”:

The “First Covenant” was CONFIRMED between God and man by an outward sign and the blood of circumcision. The covenant sign was cut in the flesh.

God’s plan was designed to reveal to man the “Right Arm of God” which is the “Word of God” and testifies of the “Righteousness of God” and the “Kingdom Laws of God” to all those whom God had made his covenant with, that he might through the “Word of God” that was in the “ark of the testimony”, bring many to the day of promise which would be fulfilled in Christ, when Jesus Christ would triumph over the “Law of sin unto Death” by becoming

obedient to the power of death, therefore paying the price of death that sin demanded, though Christ was not in debt to sin.

Christ triumphed over the “injustice of sin” and the “father of sin”. Christ took the authority of The “Law of sin unto Death” out of the way by paying an undue penalty with his own death and arose again from that death unto “Everlasting Life”.

**Exd 25:21**

And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee.

The “Ten Commandments”.

This was the schoolmaster to bring those who were under the “First Covenant” to the fulfillment of the promise of eternal life, which is fulfilled by a better Covenant, a new and living way establishing the “Law of God” in the hearts of the redeemed by the “Testimony of Jesus Christ” which is the indwelling “Spirit of Righteousness” which is also called the “Spirit of Grace” and the “Spirit of God”.

**Hbr 10:15 - Hbr 10:22**

[Whereof] the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before,

This [is] the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;

And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more

Now where remission of these [is, there is] no more offering for sin.

Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,

By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;

And [having] an high priest over the house of God;

Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

The “Spirit of Prophecy” the “Word of God” which reveals “God’s Righteousness” or image, is the fulfillment of the “Law of God” these dwelling in the heart of the redeemed manifest the “Testimony of Jesus Christ”! The Book, “The Revelation of Jesus Christ” reveals these concepts to us so intimately.

#### **Rev 19:7 - Rev 19:10**

Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.

And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed [are] they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.

And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See [thou do it] not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

### Rev 19:11

And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him [was] called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

### Rev 19:12

His eyes [were] as a flame of fire, and on his head [were] many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

### Rev 19:13

And he [was] clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

Man in the beginning that is the first Adam, was created in the “Righteous Image of God”. Man transgressed against the “Righteousness of God” which is God’s image or likeness, and came under the curse of sin by the “father of sin” and began conforming to the “image of the fallen angel” which is also the “father of sin”. The fallen angel beguiled, that is tricked Eve, into becoming his accomplice thereby leading Adam, through the weakness of Eve, to sin also against the Righteousness of God.

Eve, being separated from Adam by the “law of sin” was “taken away” and Adam was left. Eve was taken from Adam by her allegiance to the “father of sin”, entering with him into rebellion against God. Adam because of his desire toward Eve also sinned and he also was taken away from the “Righteousness of God” by the “seed of rebellion” thereby coming under the power of the “Law of sin unto death” also.

All of the angelic hosts of heaven were created by God in the “Image of his Righteousness” which is the “Law of God’s

Kingdom” and is still “The Pattern” for the “New Creation” and the “Kingdom of God”.

The Testimony of God is true when he spoke of the creation of man and said, let us make man in our image. All the hosts of heaven who pledge their allegiance to the “Kingdom of God” are made in the “image of God” and are partakers of the “Righteousness of God”.

### **Gen 1:26**

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

The “birth of sin” through the “weakness of Eve” brought into existence a spiritual child you might say, the “son of the fallen angel”, that opposed Righteousness and all that is called God!

Is sin and disobedience in man called a child of disobedience birthed by the flesh of man?

No! Sin is the son of the fallen angel because the spirit of wickedness has come from the “corrupt seed” of his father, the “fallen angel” has “taken the heart and temple of the sinner” away from God.

The “fallen angel” might be considered to be a trinity by the perspective of many mainstream evangelical ministries.

The erroneous interpretation of scriptures by the Pagans and Greeks established the current theology concerning the Godhead under the Roman Emperor Constantine. Emperor worship was also common in that day as they were considered deity and should be worshipped also.

Constantine was very familiar with the gods of Rome and the trinities as they existed within Pagan religions, ritual and worship. Constantine's desire was to bring all religions together into one system of worship. Did he accomplish his goal?

You have to be the judge of that based on your study of "God's Word" and your knowledge of today's Christian theology, rituals and worship.

Constantine was the Chief Pagan priest in Rome he never denounced his office even refusing Christian baptism, but yielded to being sprinkled by water according to history on his death bed.

Constantine also established a memorial to himself and the Apostles. Constantine proclaimed himself as the thirteenth Apostle surrounded by the original twelve. Constantine's exaltation of himself would erroneously remove either Paul or Mathias from their Apostleship and name Constantine as their replacement.

Constantine gave the power of the Roman military and civil authority to the politically connected men in Rome who took advantage after much suffering and persecution of the Churches of Christ prior to Constantine's rule. The political and civil authority seized the reins of Christianity peacefully through Constantine's political agenda of restructuring government to include the Churches as extensions of civil government and authority.

Lucifer is the "father of sin", Lucifer is "sin's father", and the "spirit of lawlessness" is the "Spirit of disobedience" in the "children of Disobedience" which is rebellion! Eph. 2:2

Constantine's view of the Godhead would today recognize Lucifer as a trinity also, a father, a son and a spirit at war against the "Kingdom of God in Heaven and Earth".

The "God of Heaven" is the "Father of Creation", "The Son" is "The Word" "The Testimony of God", and the "Spirit of Righteousness" is the "Spirit of Grace" which is the "Spirit of God". And these three are one Lord! Deut. 6:4

**Mar 12:28 - Mar 12:31**

And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that he had answered them well, asked him, Which is the first commandment of all?

And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments [is], Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this [is] the first commandment.

This verse speaks of the first four of the “Ten Commandments” man’s responsibility to God! Exodus 20

And the second [is] like, [namely] this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these. Exodus 20

This verse speaks of the last six of the “Ten Commandments” man’s responsibility to his fellow man.

Paul said, “There is “One Lord”, “One Faith” “One God” “One Spirit” and “One body” and “One Baptism”

### **Eph 4:3 - Eph 4:7**

Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

[There is] one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;

One Lord, one faith, one baptism,

One God and Father of all, who [is] above all, and through all, and in you all.

But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ.

Paul spoke on this and the finality of the day that all sin shall be judged by the “Righteousness of Christ”. It seems Paul is implying that man is again going to be tempted to deny the “Word of God” and rather than conforming to the image of “Jesus Christ the Righteous” and the “Everlasting Gospel” man will once again deny and oppose the “Righteousness of God” or the “Word of God” again “believing the lie” and worshiping the “father of lies” in rebellion against the “Righteousness of God’s Kingdom”.

The enemy of God, “the fallen angel” is still using the “power of sin” to take the wicked away! Those who are taken are under the curse of “sin unto death.” An allegory of this is their dead bodies being consumed by the vultures (eagles). Christ spoke of this in a parable in the “Book of Luke”. The dead bodies of the unclean were not buried but cast on the garbage heap, the dump which was located outside of the city walls. (Without the “Kingdom of God”)

### **Luk 17:36**

Two [men] shall be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left.

### **Luk 17:37**

And they answered and said unto him, Where, Lord? And he said unto them, Wheresoever the body [is], thither will the eagles be gathered together.

Those who are taken away are taken by the “spirit of sin and wickedness” which is “Lawlessness” they are in bondage to the “man of sin”. Sin and disobedience is the image and nature of the lawless beast.

## 2Th 2:2 - 2Th 2:4

That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.

Let no man deceive you by any means: for [that day shall not come], **except there come a falling away first**, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

**Who opposeth** and exalteth himself above **all that is called God, or that is worshipped**; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God. (Sin is opposed to Righteousness)

**Disobedience to “God’s Word” takes away man** from the Righteousness of Jesus Christ and the “Ten Commandments” these “Two Witnesses” are the “Testimony of God” and his Righteousness. Rev. 14:12, Rev 11:3

## 2Th 2:7 - 2Th 2:12

For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth [will let], until he be taken out of the way.

And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:

[Even him], whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,

And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie:

That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

The “man of sin” is being revealed, and the “Gospel of Jesus Christ” that Paul preached is exemplified in *Acts 2:38* by the Apostle Peter. The message preached by the obedience of those that heard and obeyed brought the “Righteousness of Jesus Christ” to rule in the heart and temple of Man, as it still does also today. Peter testified of this to them gathered with him in the upper room.

#### **Act 2:38 - Act 2:42**

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, [even] as many as the Lord our God shall call.

And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation.

Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added [unto them] about three thousand souls.

And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.

Many are as those who mocked Noah, saying thou fool, thou doest a great labor and for nothing. But the Bible makes it clear

that faith is not a thought but faith is an action principle when it is manifest to serve the “Kingdom of God.”

Paul wrote of those who had no faith to apply the action principle.

#### Hbr 4:2

For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard [it].

#### Hbr 11:7

By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.

#### Hbr 11:8

By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went.

The “Second Covenant” is for us who live now in the “Everlasting Kingdom”. Those who are circumcised by the “Word of God” have cut off the occasion to the flesh to revel in sin against God! The “Laws of God” are not anymore on tables of stone before the eyes, but are written in the heart of those who are redeemed from the curse of sin and the “Law of sin unto death” has no power over the righteous!

The saints of the “Old Testament” and “New Testament” are of the “One Promise” and by “One Seed” which is Christ! The “Righteousness of Jesus Christ” is “God’s Word” in you!

Paul said, the “mystery of iniquity” is revealed, and the “Mystery of God” is revealed.

**Col 1:26 - Col 1:28**

[Even] the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints:

To whom God would make known what [is] the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:

Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus:

The “Righteousness of God” was manifest in the “Ten Commandments” and revealed that “Life of Righteousness” that Adam was once a partaker of. Man through the sin of Adam, became “divorced from Righteousness” and became married to sin.

Man sat under the judgment of the “Law of Sin and death” because he had partaken of the rebellion offered him by the “sin of disobedience” rebelling against God’s Word and “God’s Law”.

Man yielded himself to believe the lies of the serpent and allowed the righteousness of “God’s Law” to become unattainable because man came under the curse of death.

The curse worked death or unrighteousness in those who came under the curse because sin revealed another law, which gendered to death rather than Righteousness.

Death came to mankind by the “father of sin” in the “Garden of Eden” because Satan’s rebellion had introduced a “Rule of Law” by

conduct, that revealed another Law which had no power nor did it exist until sin or disobedience to God had been committed.

Death the “Rule of this Law” applied to “sin” did not exist until the fallen enemy introduced this power by his manifestation of disobedience and rebellion which we understand to be sin by transgression or disobedience.

Sin had stolen man’s heritage and authority over death and all unrighteousness whereby the image or the nature of God also was now in contrast to man’s fallen condition.

C: The 10 Commandments reflect the Nature and Character of God. The fate of mankind was governed in Moses day by a set of ordinances to enforce and govern those who failed to obey or conform to the Character of God. It also reproved those who believed themselves to be without fault and above reproach:

D: Under the first covenant “The Law of God” the five “Books of Moses” included ordinances governing the execution of judgment and the consequences of man’s failure to conform to God’s will and the “Ten Commandments.” God by the sign of circumcision confirmed the first covenant that God made with Abraham as a child of promise. The promise through Jesus Christ would bring those who were in bondage to the “Law of Sin and Death”, and had become the posterity of the fallen angel to a future “City of Refuge.” Christ who paid the penalty of death without sin, could now pardon those who repented and desired not to be under the curse of sin and demonstrated faith in God’s promise.

The rudiments of the world are disobedience and rebellion against Righteousness or obedience to “God’s Word”. **The ordinances of the world are the consequences of sin which is death.** Those who are given to sin, which is the rudiments of the world are bound to the ordinances of sin, which is the penalty of death demanded by the law of sin and death. *Col. 2:20*

This law is to the credit of Lucifer who by his rebellion and disobedience defied “God’s Law”. **The fallen angel caused the law of “sin unto death” to appear because he introduced the concept of sin he is the father of sin!**

In the “New Testament” under “The Second Covenant” now we may become a partaker of “Christ’s baptisms” his death, burial and resurrection through obeying the “Gospel of Jesus Christ.” Obedience to *Acts 2:38* brings mankind into “The Kingdom of the living God.” Christ then pardons those who are identified with him from the penalty of past sins to give them power to overcome the spirit of disobedience that they may live Righteously, free from the curse of sin. Christ in them is Righteous and is able to help them fulfill all the “Law of God which is Righteousness.”

E: The “Law of Sin and Death” was held to be a valid contract by God’s Law it was a Righteous judgment that should come upon all who rebel against God. Satan came to accuse the brethren before the throne of God because man was under the curse of Sin and worthy before God of death. The soul that sins it shall die!

Satan held the contract of those who had made an agreement with death whether willingly or unwillingly they had come under the curse, and he had begotten them through the fall into sin and rebellion.

F. It seemed at that time that there was no escape for those who were guilty, and the enemy loved to flaunt this fact in the presence of God. God however seeing his deceit and self gratifying behavior had a plan to destroy his power to take away his boasting and to put the Law of Sin and Death in the Hands of one who would exercise justice and mercy on the behalf of those who desired to be free from the curse that had come upon them by the sins of their fathers.

G. The “Law and the Ordinances” revealed by God to Moses were the schoolmaster to bring those under the “first covenant” to Jesus Christ and in Christ all Righteousness is fulfilled.

No person under the law was saved by the “ceremonial ordinances” of the temple! However the blood of a substitute offering preserved them in a period of time which the bible speaks of as the longsuffering of God, a type of probation that postponed their sentencing until the contracts of those who were bound by the Law of sin and death, were placed under the authority of the Messiah.

Christ would execute justice based on the repentant heart of those who through their obedience honored the “Word of God” which would one day become flesh. The “Law of Righteousness” would then be counted unto them being identified with Messiah, when the “Word that became flesh appeared unto men, and took away the authority of death from those who under the first covenant obeyed “Gods Word”.

Thusly they being obedient and offering sacrifice was a shew of their faith by their works that they believed in the promise of liberty from the Curse of Sin.

The faith of those under the “first covenant was manifest by their obedience to God and their trust in the “Word of God” concerning the coming of the redeemer when they would be judged according to the “Word of God” and “The Spirit of Christ.”

H. The fulfillment of the Law is Righteousness, the new creation, the new creature manifest by the “Spirit of Christ” which is also the “Spirit of Grace”, in those who have been joined to Christ!

These having become heirs, now reign with Christ through the Spirit, having taken on his Character, the “Law of God” is written in their hearts and the “Testimony of Christ” is in their mouth. These also have been given a “New Nature” so that by becoming a “New Creature” they by Nature, the “Nature of Christ”, now keep all the “Laws of God” without the tablets of stone being displayed as a reminder of their former disobedience.

The stones are no longer necessary the “Laws of God” and the “Character of God” is in the “New Creation”. “The Kingdom of God” is within you.

### **Luk 17:20**

And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, he answered them and said, the kingdom of God cometh not with observation:

### **Luk 17:21**

Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God is within you.

The Laws are written upon the heart instead of upon the stones. The “law of God” is understood and kept now by the regeneration process of the “Spirit of Christ”. Those who were blind to the “Moral Character” and “Nature of God” revealed in the “Ten Commandments” are no longer blind but now they see the “Righteousness of God in Jesus Christ “The Word of God” has become flesh.

Those who are beguiled by the enemy to twist the Word of God as the serpent did when he beguiled Eve in the Garden of Eden are unconverted and desire to excuse man from the responsibility of his Lawlessness and they have become blind to the “Spirit of Grace” which is Christ in you!

Those who by nature deny Gods authority and obey the lusts of the flesh, they are Law breakers and the Lawless spirit that motivates their lusts and whispers excuses in their ears is an enmity against God.

1. Even if man had been able to obey the Ten Commandments perfectly yet he would have remained under the Law of Sin and death because of the curse of Adam’s sin.

2. Satan held the contracts men had made with death by disobedience and sin beginning with Adam, the first created man that would bring forth the genealogies of mankind.

3. The only hope was to prove the wicked one to be unjust in his enforcement of the “Law of Sin and Death. Christ would be the one to triumph over the enemy and the “Law of sin and death.” Christ was brought under the “Law of Sin and Death” by the enemy of God. Christ being brought under the curse unjustly could not be held by the contract between Sin and Death. Christ resurrected and took the keys or the authority to enforce the contracts of those bound by the “Law of Sin and death away” from Satan.

4. All that would come to Jesus Christ who tasted Death for all that would obey the “Word of God” may receive pardon from the sins of their Father Adam.

5. We being obedient to the gospel of Jesus Christ have become a new creature and have been born again from above. We have been converted in the inner man by the Spirit of Christ. Christ is the Spirit of Grace whereby we may overcome all manner of sin and affliction the enemy may bring to us. Man by Nature now operates in the Kingdom of God having the Holy Ghost that is Jesus Christ as the high priest and king of the temple of God.

6. Paul said ye are the Temple of God if it be that Christ be in you. God did not limit this covenant relationship to only Israel and spoke of the blessedness of keeping the Sabbath and of the wild riot of sinners.

A. The Blessed:

**Isa 56:1**

Thus saith the LORD, Keep ye judgment, and do justice: for my salvation [is] near to come, and my righteousness to be revealed.

**Isa 56:2**

Blessed [is] the man [that] doeth this, and the son of man [that] layeth hold on it; that keepeth the sabbath from polluting it, and keepeth his hand from doing any evil.

B. The son of the stranger included in God's plan:

**Isa 56:6**

Also the sons of the stranger, that join themselves to the LORD, to serve him, and to love the name of the LORD, to be his servants, every one that keepeth the sabbath from polluting it, and taketh hold of my covenant

**Isa 56:7**

Even them will I bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their sacrifices [shall be] accepted upon mine altar; for mine house shall be called an house of prayer for all people.

**Isa 56:8**

The Lord GOD which gathereth the outcasts of Israel saith, Yet will I gather [others] to him, beside those that are gathered unto him.

C. The riot of sinners and a false profession they are "taken away":

**Isa 56:9 - Isa 56:12**

All ye beasts of the field, come to devour, [yea], all ye beasts in the forest.

His watchmen [are] blind: they are all ignorant, they [are] all dumb dogs, they cannot bark; sleeping, lying down, loving to slumber.

Yea, [they are] greedy dogs [which] can never have enough, and they [are] shepherds [that] cannot understand: they all look to their own way, every one for his gain, from his quarter.

Come ye, [say they], I will fetch wine, and we will fill ourselves with strong drink; and to morrow shall be as this day, [and] much more abundant.

Yea, [they are] greedy dogs [which] can never have enough, and they [are] shepherds [that] cannot understand: they all look to their own way, every one for his gain, from his quarter.

Come ye, [say they], I will fetch wine, and we will fill ourselves with strong drink; and to morrow shall be as this day, [and] much more abundant.

God warned those who would depart from obeying the commandments that he had given Israel in duet 28 in the day that they departed from hearing and obeying the Word of God that a curse would overtake them.

But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

Cursed [shalt] thou [be] in the city, and cursed [shalt] thou [be] in the field.

Cursed [shall be] thy basket and thy store.

Cursed [shall be] the fruit of thy body, and the fruit of thy land, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep.

Cursed [shalt] thou [be] when thou comest in, and cursed [shalt] thou [be] when thou goest out.

The LORD shall send upon thee cursing, vexation, and rebuke, in all that thou settest thine hand unto for to do, until thou be destroyed, and until thou perish quickly; because of the wickedness of thy doings, whereby thou hast forsaken me.

God suggested a second covenant greater then the first when God would write his Laws upon the heart rather then upon the stones.

For this [is] the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:

For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:

Rom 7:22

I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.

Rom 7:25

Because the carnal mind [is] enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. Rom 8:7

So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God. Rom 8:9

But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. Rom 8:10

And if Christ [be] in you, the body [is] dead because of sin; but the Spirit [is] life because of righteousness. Rom 8:11

But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you. Rom 8:12

For there is no respect of persons with God. Romans 2:11-15

For as many as have sinned without law shall also perish without law: and as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law;

For not the hearers of the law [are] just before God, but the doers of the law shall be justified.

For when the Gentiles, which have not the law, do by nature the things contained in the law, these, having not the law, are a law unto themselves:

Which shew the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and [their] thoughts the mean(Between themselves) while accusing or else excusing one another;)

For circumcision verily profiteth, if thou keep the law: but if thou be a breaker of the law, thy circumcision is made uncircumcision. Rom 2:25 -29

Therefore if the uncircumcision keep the righteousness of the law, shall not his uncircumcision be counted for circumcision?

And shall not uncircumcision which is by nature, if it fulfil the law, judge thee, who by the letter and circumcision dost transgress the law?

For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither [is that] circumcision, which is outward in the flesh

But he [is] a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision [is that] of the heart, in the spirit, [and] not in the letter; whose praise [is] not of men, but of God.

Seeing [it is] one God, which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith. Rom 3:30-31

Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the law.

We must consider the law whether it be “The Law of Sin and Death” or “The Ten Commandments.”

Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof. Rom 6:12-18

Neither yield ye your members [as] instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members [as] instruments of righteousness unto God.

For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace. (The Spirit of grace that is Christ, has conquered the “Law of Sin and death”)

What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid.

Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?

But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.

Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.

## The Law is spiritual

Wherefore the law [is] holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good. Rom 7:12

For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.  
Rom 7:14

I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me.  
Rom 7:21-22

For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:

## Those in Christ walk after the Spirit

For "the law of the Spirit of life" in Christ Jesus hath made me free from "the law of sin and death." Rom 8:2

For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

For to be carnally minded [is] death; but to be spiritually minded [is] life and peace.

# God's Nature, and Righteousness

## The Timelessness of the Ten Commandments

God is of Holy Character, Timeless and immutable, God's desire has not changed for man's restoration and perfection. When God made the covenant with Abraham the covenant was to encompass all people. Though God brought the promised seed through a people whose genealogy is traceable to Abraham the promise was to benefit many nations.

*Genesis 17:4*

As for me, behold, my covenant [is] with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many nations.

The Hebrew word nations is translated Goy – a heathen, Gentile people. The idea that Salvation was only for the Judeans and the Gentiles just got lucky does not hold water. God desires to make all of mankind the apple of his eye. God was reaching for you, me and the lowest heathen or gentile people when he established the first covenant with Abraham.

God loves with agape love but his righteousness will not allow for any compromise of "God's Law" Truth, Justice and Righteousness.

The first covenant like the second covenant has two parts of Law that are at work. The “Law of God” executes Righteousness which is the “nature of God” that leads to eternal life. The “Law of Sin” executes “Judgment and Death”. Sin is simply disobedience in many forms and brings death.

Unless we understand these two laws how they operate and how they relate to mankind and “The Gospel” we may find ourselves bogged down in a terrible deception. Many erroneously teach that the “Law of God” was not good enough.

Many believe that the word law in the “Old Testament” and “New Testament” always refers to the “Ten Commandments” or the temple ceremonies. The truth is we must consider “The Law of God” the “Ten Commandments” and “The Law of Sin and Death” separately and the ordinances that govern the execution of judgments pertaining to these two laws. When reading scripture we must be aware of the difference in these terms or we will not gain a proper and truthful understanding of the Bible.

Paul tells us the Law was Righteous and Spiritual, the Law was good it was weak only because man was weak and not able to live up to the righteousness that the Law of God demanded.

Wherefore the law [is] holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good. Rom 7:12

For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.  
Rom 7:14

Paul praised the Gentiles that were born again believers in Jesus Christ. The Spirit of Christ, the Grace of God was in them. Paul said, these are not circumcised according to the law under the first covenant, but their testimony bears witness to the Righteousness that was by the Law required.

Paul argued that their uncircumcision because they fulfilled the Righteousness of the Law has become circumcision by the inward man.

Paul told those who rejected salvation through Christ that held to the “first covenant” of circumcision and the ordinances under the first covenant that ye being circumcised do not keep the “Righteousness of the law” so your circumcision has become uncircumcision. These men did not have the “Law of Righteousness in their heart, which is Christ they had not obeyed the Gospel of Jesus Christ. These men were not born again. The scriptures reveal that we must be born from above.

Paul said, in *Romans 2:15*

**These shew the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and [their] thoughts the mean (Between themselves) quote added by me. while accusing or else excusing one another;**

Where did this Work of the Law (Righteousness) that was in their hearts come from? Who brought it? Who planted the “Righteous works” of “God’s Law” in the hearts of these men?

These men before they obeyed “The Gospel” *Acts 2:38* and followed Christ into the death of water baptism and then were joined to the “Spirit of Jesus Christ” were bankrupt. They stumbled at “God’s Law” and the Righteousness of the Law they could not keep!

**The only possible answer is that Jesus Christ is the fulfillment of the Law in that the Righteous nature demanded and represented by the Law of God can be no less then the Savior Jesus Christ!**

**Therefore this Righteousness that the “Ten Commandments” demand for fulfillment is the “Law of God’s Kingdom” This law is come from, and is the very “Nature and Righteousness of God”. It is a part of what God is by the “Ten Commandments” God reveals himself to his creation and this part of God cannot and will never be changed or taken away for any reason!**

**The Kingdom within you is the Righteousness of Christ, “The Word”, “The Law of God that became Flesh that we might be saved”!**

**The Ten Commandments represent the personality, character and nature of a Holy God, Jesus Christ that has no beginning or end of days. The Law therefore has been in existence as long as God and “God’s Kingdom” has existed.**

**To deny the value of obedience and Righteousness that the “Ten Commandments” demand and represent is to deny Jesus Christ as Creator, Redeemer and Holy Ghost! To deny these is to deny the “Kingdom of God” and the “Righteousness of God” and the Laws “God’s Righteousness” forever establish!**

The “Law of God” and “The Ten Commandments” require a Righteousness that could only be fulfilled and honored by one such as Jesus Christ a perfect Adam. The “Law of Sin and Death” could not be annulled without the shedding of the blood of one who was innocent and guiltless of all sin.

The execution of the “Law of Sin” unjustly by the enemy of God upon the perfect Adam, Jesus Christ, violated the principle purpose and the “Rule of Law” that justified the existence of the “Law of Sin unto Death.” This is why the Law of Sin and Death could not hold Christ in the grave under the grip of death.

Jesus Christ resurrected and triumphed over hell and death and took these keys or this authority from the enemy. This authority cannot be exercised over those who are joined together with Christ through obedience to the gospel of Jesus Christ

Those who do not have a relationship through the “Gospel of Christ” according to the scriptures are still in bondage to the “Law of Sin and Death” and they do not have the promise of the “Kingdom of God”.

When the end of all things has come and the great white throne judgment is completed there will be no more enemies of God, no fallen angels and no sickness or death. There will be no more sin. There will be no more sinners. There will be no more a “Law of Sin and Death.”

The principle purpose for this law will no longer exist nor will it be remembered anymore. The fact that sin will not exist anymore will annul the “Law of sin and death.” It will be as though the curse of sin never existed.

God’s Righteousness will continue forever. The Law and the Righteousness of the “Law of God” will have no end nor does it have a beginning. “God is Righteous”, and the eternal “God is Holy”.

Practically everyone can agree upon nine of the “Ten Commandments”. However the “Sabbath Day Commandment” to be kept on the 7<sup>th</sup> day sundown to sundown is one that many argue about and refuse to honor, many also refuse to honor the Gospel recorded in the “book of Acts” *Chapter 2:38*

I can only conclude that the spirit that excuses one from honoring “God’s Law” and claims “God’s Law of Righteousness” is dead, is the same spirit that dishonors the Gospel of *Acts 2:38* which fulfills all Righteousness when we become partakers with Christ in his death through baptism, being raised from that death as a new creature then are we joined to the Spirit of Christ to become partakers also of his resurrection.

This relationship to Christ is required to keep the Righteousness of “God’s Law” in the “Ten Commandments”.

When we identify with Christ's death, burial and resurrection and we are joined in one Spirit to Christ, the "Law of Sin and Death" can no longer be executed to us because we have repented we have been accepted by Jesus Christ we have been sanctified by the Spirit of Jesus Christ. Now because of "Christ's Righteousness" we have power to abstain from sin. And we have been justified by the "Righteous Testimony of Jesus Christ" and the witness of "God's Law" in our hearts.

Many do not believe that the scripture text of *Matt. 24:15, 20* has been fulfilled yet. Some however believe this was fulfilled in the year 70A.D. with the destruction of the city Jerusalem and the Jewish Temple.

Both of these groups would have to admit that the original 7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath is being observed according to the Words of our Lord Jesus Christ!

When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)

But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day:

God said, Remember the Sabbath day and keep it Holy! God considered his commandment to be "Righteous Law." God felt so strongly about this Law that the penalty for breaking this Law was death.

Breaking the 4<sup>th</sup> commandment comes under the same "Rule of Law" "The law of sin and death" as did also "the sin of Adam," "the sin of Disobedience."

To say that we may now violate this commandment in any way from when it was given is to say that because of the Righteousness of Jesus Christ we may break all “Ten Commandments” without coming again under the “Law of Sin and Death.” NON-SENSE!

If we are reading in scripture that seventh day Sabbath breaking is OK we are misunderstanding the context of scripture and we are also misunderstanding the Righteous and Immutable nature of God.

Because some have not the “Word of God” they view the “Laws of God” from a carnal perspective not understanding the Scriptures when they speak concerning “God’s Law” as a “Delight of the Lord” Psalms. 1:1-2, 37:4, 119:35, Rom 7:22, Isaiah 58:13-14,

One particular case in point which is applied in many of the arguments against keeping the “Seventh Day Sabbath” are scriptures that are misunderstood by the reader, therefore the message is misconstrued

Col. 2: 20-22

Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances, (*The temptation of Sin!*) added by me.

(Touch not; taste not; handle not;

This scripture might be considered a paradox. A paradox is; a statement that is seemingly contradictory or opposed to common sense and yet is perhaps true.

When we are filled with the Holy Ghost which some call the Spirit of Grace or the Spirit of Christ we are then free from the “Law of Sin and Death” our desire should not be to come under that bondage of sin again.

We should flee from the enemy if he tries to snare us again to partake of that which is forbidden, and we should keep the “Law of Righteousness”

The point of *Col. 2:20-22* may seem trivial to many but if God’s law forbade a sin as the “Ten Commandments” instruct us that “God’s Law” is Righteousness then we should not be tempted to be under the bondage of any sin, no matter how trivial it may seem!

If Christ be in you why are you wrestling with or compromising with the lusts of the flesh and the desires of this world?

What if this scripture pointed to more pronounced sins, such as, fornication, stealing and murder? How would this read to you, would it be acceptable to partake of those things?

Col. 2: 20-22

Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances, (*The temptation of Sin!*) added by me.

(Touch not; taste not; handle not;) **Eve and Adam’s sin was disobedience!**

or (fornicate not; steal not; murder not;)

God would owe those who died under the penalty of death an apology if the fourth commandment was not as righteous as all the other “Ten commandments.”

The fallen angel has always understood disobedience to be sin and he has attacked the Commandments of God that are most personally and pointedly presented to all of us individually to REMEMBER!

The enemy has also attacked the means by which man may be released from the curse of the “Law of Sin and Death.” Man when he is joined to Christ, receives the “Spirit of Grace” we are given “Righteousness by Christ” to fulfill the Righteousness that “the Law of God” the “Ten Commandments” requires in us to keep them.

### **Exd 31:16**

Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the sabbath, to observe the sabbath throughout their generations, [for] a perpetual covenant.

Definition of Perpetual:

- 1) long duration, antiquity, futurity, for ever, ever, everlasting, evermore, perpetual, old, ancient, world
- a) ancient time, long time (of past)
- b) (of future)
  - 1) for ever, always
  - 2) continuous existence, perpetual
  - 3) everlasting, indefinite or unending future, eternity

### **Rom 9:6 - Rom 9:8**

Not as though the word of God hath taken none effect. For they [are] not all Israel, which are of Israel:

Neither, because they are the seed of Abraham, [are they] all children: but, In Isaac shall thy seed be called.

That is, They which are the children of the flesh, these [are] not the children of God: but the children of the promise are counted for the seed.

The promised seed is Jesus Christ, those who are Christ's are “children of promise” and are born from above these are the Israel of God!

Paul said, If your circumcised or not, it doesn't matter it isn't important but keeping the "Commandments" is important!

### **1Cr 7:19**

Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but the keeping of the commandments of God.

Paul said, if any man thinks himself a prophet to bear in mind the things he teaches are the "Commandments of God"! Paul even taught that women ought to be silent in the church according to the Law in the synagogues.

### **1Cr 14:37**

If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.

I John revealed to us that **if you love God and know him** you will **keep his commandments**. If the Word of God abide in you then walk as Christ also walked.

### **1Jo 2:3 -6**

And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.

He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him.

He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.

Christ said, many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord have we not done many wonderful things prophesying in your name, healing and casting out devils? And I will say, **depart from me I never knew you**, ye who work iniquity.

**We must not deny the “Word of God” or “The Word of God” will deny knowing us!**

**Mat 10:32 -33**

Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven.

But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.

**Mat 10:34**

Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.

**Rev 19:15 - 16**

And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations; and he shall rule them with a rod of iron; and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

And he hath on [his] vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

**Rev 12:5**

And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron; and her child was caught up unto God, and [to] his throne.

The enemy hates those who follow the Lamb who are obedient to “God’s Laws” the “Ten Commandments”!

**Rev 12:17**

And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

## 1Jo 3:21-24

Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, [then] have we confidence toward God.

And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.

And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.

And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

Lawbreakers who hate the “Word of God” and his “Commandments” cannot receive from God!

## Jam 4:3

Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume [it] upon your lusts.

adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

How do we know those who truly Love of God? If you love the Righteousness of the “Ten Commandments” you will love the “Righteousness of Jesus Christ”!

## 1Jo 5:1 - 4

Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.

By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.

For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous

For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, [even] our faith.

How do we know them who are in error?

**The anti-Christ is Lawless and does not confess that the “Word of God” was made flesh nor does the anti-Christ confess that the “Ten Commandments” are Holy, “God’s Law” is righteous or that Christ came that they might be fulfilled and written in the hearts of God’s people as the prophets have said.**

The “Book of Revelations” speaks of those who overcome the beast, his mark and his name by keeping “God’s Word” “God’s Commandments”.

### **Rev 14:12 - 13**

Here is the patience of the saints: here [are] they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed [are] the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them.

The prophet Isaiah spoke of keeping the Sabbath day in the future “New Heavens” and the “New Earth”.

### **Isa 66:22–23**

For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain.

And it shall come to pass, [that] from one new moon to another, and from one Sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the LORD

## Rom 9:29

And as Esaias said before, Except the Lord of Sabaoth had left us a seed, we had been as Sodom, and been made like unto Gomorrah.

- a) Lord of the armies of Israel, as those who are under the leadership and protection of Jehovah maintain his cause in war.

The Righteous Law of God vs. The unrighteousness of sin and death.

3. Christ now gives us a license to sin and God now accepts sin as being OK so man can do anything he pleases without consequence as long as he tells Jesus afterwards?
4. God has never changed the Ten Commandments, they are still valid! Man has been tempted as he was in the garden by a smooth tongued Charlatan to believe that God didn't know the difference between the word "forget" or "remember" or that the Sabbath Day was supposed to mean something else, when God wrote the 4<sup>th</sup> Commandment with his own finger.
5. God didn't know at the time that he wrote the "Ten Commandments" when Jesus Christ would be born and what day Christians would decide or vote to worship God!
6. We should pretend we don't see it since we know God made a mistake!

7. God scored 90% on correct knowledge of his own righteous Law. We should give him an A+ everyone makes mistakes.

The correct answer is number four the same number as the Commandment that admonishes us to keep the Sabbath Day holy and to do no servile work for monetary gain nor to intentionally profane the sabbath..

Many today have created and worship forbidden images through their imagination of God. The problem of erroneous interpretations of scriptures, and traditions that have their origins outside of the sacred worship of Yahweh also lends to the problem of idolatry, paganism and compromise.

The fallen angel has aimed his guns against the scriptures in hopes of perverting the “Gospel of Salvation” to lead many away from the saving power of Jesus Christ. The enemy is instituting another Gospel and another Christ, which does not destroy the works of the devil, nor transform the nature of fallen man, that he might conform to the image of God’s Son Jesus Christ.

Paul wrote of this attack of evil coming against those who believe on and preach the Name of Jesus Christ and warned of the error that arose from them in his day.

I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel:

Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ.

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But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. *Gal 1:6*

God has always desired to see obedience rather than sacrifice because obedience genders toward “The Law of Righteousness” and sacrifice toward “The Law of Sin and Death.”

The Law of Sin unto death is a Righteous Judgment of God upon the rebellion of sin and transgression. However the appearance of sin that required this judgment was evil brought into the world by the fallen angel “The Bible” calls him Lucifer, the serpent, the dragon etc.

The enemy has always tried to persuade mankind to make his own laws and justify himself with excuses or knowledge learned from his predecessor’s. Man many times judges his own ability to reason and think to be above God, rather than simply becoming obedient to God and his Word.

Man through his own knowledge of good and evil has been exalted in civilization. God and his Word has been denigrated and castigated by the enemies of God.

The enemies of God are all who knowingly or unknowingly commit treason and rebellion against the “Kingdom of God” and the “Throne of God in Heaven and on Earth”.

In conclusion we have come to the everlasting covenant, everlasting possession, everlasting God, everlasting priesthood, everlasting statute, everlasting arms, everlasting doors, everlasting to everlasting, everlasting remembrance, everlasting righteousness, everlasting testimony, everlasting kingdom, everlasting foundation, everlasting Father, everlasting strength, everlasting burnings, everlasting joy, everlasting salvation, everlasting kindness, everlasting sign, everlasting name, everlasting light, everlasting king, everlasting confusion, everlasting reproach, everlasting love, everlasting dominion, everlasting life, everlasting fire, everlasting punishment, everlasting habitations, everlasting consolation, power everlasting, everlasting chains.

How shall we escape the “everlasting punishments” of the wicked and embrace the “Everlasting Righteousness of God” to be translated into the “Everlasting Kingdom of God”?

We must humble ourselves and become as little children, and obey the Father’s pattern for restoration by becoming obedient to the “Everlasting Gospel” of “Jesus Christ”

Will you be called a child of God, or a child of disobedience? *Eph. 2:2*

### **Rev 3:20 - Rev 3:22**

Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

Are you truly following Jesus Christ is he truly your King of Glory?

Will you keep “God’s Commandments” and drink of the cup that Christ drank from by humbling yourself to follow Christ into his Kingdom and be baptized, into the “Name of Jesus Christ” for the remission of sins? See **Acts 2:38**

When we identify ourselves with the suffering and death of Jesus Christ and “Christ’s Baptisms”, and we are also resurrected from the “death of sin” by the “Spirit of Righteousness”, which is the “Holy Ghost”, the “Spirit of Christ” in you, we shall also be counted together with Christ when he received the witness from heaven saying, This is my son in whom I am well pleased! Hear ye him! **Matt. 3:16-17, Matt 17:5, Acts 13:33, II Peter 1:16-19, Acts 2:37 – 40, Luke 17:21**

All the Feast Days or Holiday Sabbaths that represented or pointed to Christ and his coming such as the Feasts of Shavuot (Passover), Unleavened bread, Firstfruits, Pentecost, Rosh Hashanah (Feast of Trumpets), Yom Kipur (Day of Atonement), Sukkot (Feast of Booths), Simchat Torah, Hanukkah (Chanuka) and Purim, are no longer celebrated in anticipation of the coming of the Messiah.

### **1 John 4:3**

And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that [spirit] of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

Christ has come in the flesh. We are no longer under the Law of Moses. We are still bound to the “Righteousness of all the “Ten Commandments” because sin is still in the world to tempt man to enter the rebellion with the fallen angel against the righteousness of God.

Nobody has a license to sin against the kingdom Laws of God.

The born again Christian is restored in his relationship with God to a state of Spiritual Righteousness by being joined in one Spirit to Christ. Man spiritually enters into the Righteousness that the first Adam had of God before he sinned. Therefore the Kingdom of God is restored within Man.

### **Luke 17:21**

Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God is within you.

The seventh day that God hallowed and set aside is the Sabbath Day of the Lord to be observed by those who love him and know his Word.
