We are admonished to walk in the love of Jesus Christ.

Rom 14:15

But if thy brother be grieved with [thy] meat, now walkest thou not charitably. Destroy not him with thy meat, for whom Christ died.

Eph 6:12

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high [places].

Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

Above all, taking the shield of faith wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel,

For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

This information is from the Biblical accounts of the Apostle Paul who is a son and heir of God through the operation of Grace, the adoption of the Spirit, being born again from above and having the wonderful gifts of the Holy Ghost, the Grace of God, to preach the Word of God, unto those who are separated from Grace by the sin of Adam and the spirit of wickedness which now works in the children of disobedience. All accounts are from the Biblical perspective of the scriptures such as Romans Chapter 6, 7, 8 Eph 2:2-8

We will together consider the subjects of Law and Grace.

Jud 1:3

Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort [you] that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

What was the faith that was once delivered unto the saints?

The Gospel first proclaimed in Gen 3:15 would bring restoration of God's Law to humanity and the promise to Abraham was made to redeem man from the curse of sin and restore Righteousness through the promised seed.

The need for the Gospel and man's depravity was made known by the knowledge of the "Ten Commandments" The "Laws of Righteousness". Man realized his sin and remembered the Righteous Laws of God's Kingdom.

"The Ten Words – The revelation of God's Righteousness" is the Word of God the Righteousness commanded of God. The New Testament says the Word was made flesh and dwelled among men speaking of Jesus Christ!

Jud 1:4

For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

Jud 1:5-8

I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not.

And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

Likewise also these [filthy] dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.

Jud 1:14-23

And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints,

To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard [speeches] which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

These are murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh great swelling [words], having men's persons in admiration because of advantage.

But, beloved, remember ye the words which were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ;

How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts.

These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.

But ye, beloved, **building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,**

Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

And of some have compassion, making a difference:

And others save with fear, pulling [them] out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

- Law and Grace -

I will not post verbatim Dr. Scripture View's interpretations to constrain the length and volume of this overview of the Subjects of Law and Grace.

I must say from the onset of this Study that I do not intend to insult or seem rash or arrogant in any way toward other doctrines or people who may hold another doctrine. Our battles are not with each other in the flesh but we are at war against principalities and powers who seek to steal, kill and destroy all of Gods children.

Rom 6:14

For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.

It is very important to understand there are three predominant works of the law in the Bible, *The Ceremonial Law*, *Judicial Law* and *Moral Law*, in most references one is referred to, but at times two or even all three of these may be referenced as law.

Romans 7:6 is a reminder of our sins, breaking God's *Moral Law*, imputing *God's Judicial Law* or judgment and the necessity to honor *Sacrificial Law* to escape judgment for sins until the time Christ would come, and pay the price of sin with his innocent blood at Calvary for all repentant sinners.

Rom 8:2

For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

What is the Law Paul speaks about that binds man as a slave to death and makes man a partaker with the fallen angel in the rebellion against God?

What separates man from God's Kingdom, and the Spirit of Grace?

What was it in the Garden of Eden that destroyed mans relationship with God?

Is it "The Righteousness of God's Law" the "Ten Commandments" that brings death and separates man from the Spirit of God? Of course not!

Christ said, "A house divided by itself cannot stand". Are the Commandments against God?

God forbid! The Ten Commandments reveal the Gospel message in the Old Testament and revealed the way man ought to live in Righteousness.

The Ten Commandments revealed a life that is pleasing to God, representative of the character of God where man ought to live in God's Law being free from the bondage of sin! **These are the principle Kingdom Laws of God and his Government in Heaven and earth!**

All Ten of these commandments were in operation when we look at the finished creation in Genesis Chapter 2:3

We know these were in full force because there was no sin, because sin did not yet abound!

Sin had blinded Man to the Righteousness of God. Man lost sight of what God expected of those who desired to walk with God in relationship with God.

Therefore God had to make the Righteous Laws re-appear that were once in the mind and the heart of the Righteous Adam before he sinned.

The Righteous Laws had now disappeared and were nearly forgotten because of the hardness of mans heart and his desire toward the wickedness of sin and rebellion.

The Commandments were given to man by God and they revealed God's goodness that man may know what sin is.

It was God's goodness revealed to those in the world who broke the "Laws of God" The "Ten Commandments" that they might know and escape the penalty of certain death and damnation!

Is the Law of Moses and the five books of the Pentateuch what brought man into bondage in the Garden of Eden?

No! The Law God gave to Moses the first five books of **the Pentateuch contained God's Kingdom Laws which are Everlasting**, and **the Pentateuch also contains many temporal laws** that were intended by God to bring man to repent of his transgressions against the Commandments of God and by obeying the ordinances of sacrifice through the temple ceremonies it showed the sinners subjugation to God and his desire to be free from the curse of his own sins and the original sins inherited from the days of Adam and our fathers.

The curse of original sin was inherited from our father Adam from the days of old. These temporal laws of ceremonies, sacrifices and celebrations such as feast days were a shadow or celebration in faith of the future coming of the Messiah who is Jesus Christ.

God gave these temporal laws to mankind in that day so that all who had a desire to repent and walk in the Righteousness of God could be judged and then subjugate themselves to God's plan of redemption until the Messiah would come and permanently expunge their sin record.

The temporal laws succeeded Moses days and continued until Jesus Christ gave himself to be crucified at Calvary.

When the curtain fell away and revealed openly the Ark of the Covenant and the holy place where the Spirit of God would come down to dwell between the Cherubim on the mercy seat it signified the end of the Temporal Laws and ended the shadows that celebrated the hope and expectation of the Messiah's future reign.

Calvary signified that the literal Reign of Jesus Christ had come and man could now receive deliverance from sin and death and be translated by obedience to the Gospel and Spiritual rebirth into the Kingdom of God. When man is converted he can then enjoy the Laws of God's Kingdom and God's Righteousness is not grievous.

Christ has come and triumphed over death and hell. Christ's death on Calvary signified the end of the shadows the Holiday feasts were no longer a celebration of the hope of a coming day but they were now fulfilled. The sacrifices, the ceremonial laws of preparation of the priesthood that prepared them to offer the daily sacrifice this was all fulfilled at Calvary in Jesus Christ also.

Those Jew and Gentile converts who rejected Christ, and yet continued to look forward to another messiah with keeping of the feasts, the sacrifices, the ceremonies and all the other shadow feasts looking to a future coming of another Messiah were actually confessing by their own testimony that they were Anti-Christ because they did not believe the Messiah was Jesus Christ and that God the redeemer had come in the flesh.

1Jo 4:2

Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:

2Jo 1:7

For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist.

These temporal laws that Paul speaks of were all celebrations and penalties, and temporary atonements of sacrifices for sinners until the Messiah would come and redeem all that were obedient and repentant and wash away once and for all the sins both present and past with his own blood.

The Ten Commandments are not Temporary but they will for all time Condemn sin until sin ceases to exist. The Commandments are Righteous even as God is Righteous!

2Cr 4:18

While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: **for the things which are seen [are] temporal**; but **the things which are not seen [are] eternal**.

We cannot by our own merits, works or accomplishments be restored to the state of perfection as it was in the beginning with our father Adam when God placed him in the Garden of Eden on the day that man was created.

All the temporal laws of the temple, the ceremonies, the celebrations of the feast days and sacrifices, these proclaimed and were visible acts of faith by the worshipers of God that proclaimed their faith in the future coming of Jesus Christ.

These things were shadows looking forward to the coming of Jesus Christ the Messiah, the Redeemer.

The Law of Sin is God's righteous Judgment upon all who commit rebellion against God and his Kingdom. The wickedness of Sin and rebellion had caused man to be placed into bondage he became a slave to sin and death.

The Law of sin and death came into power because Adam disobeyed God and rebelled against God's commandments being persuaded by the father of sin in the Garden of Eden.

When the father of sin convinced man to disobey God he then took away man's God given dominions and made man a sinner and a partaker of his own rebellion against God.

Satan counted the loss of mans soul to his own credit, mankind had now become his subjects through the sin of disobedience and they were now

in his favor and in the rebellion with him against God, the Kingdom of God, and the Laws of God!

The Law that Paul speaks so adamantly about being free from is Sin.

Sin was introduced by the fallen angel, the serpent and did not exist until it was found in him! This element of iniquity and rebellion against the Kingdom Laws of God brings man into bondage to the father of sin and brings the Righteous Judgment of Death upon all who are imprisoned by sin!

The righteous Judgment of God's Law say's the soul that sin's it shall die!

1Cr 15:21-22

For since by man [came] death, by man [came] also the resurrection of the dead.

For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

Rom 8:2

For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Rom 8:3

For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

This means the temporal elements of the temple, the sacrifices, the feast days, the will and intensions of man could not keep all the "Commandments of God" all the time because the flesh was ruled by sin and **the Ten Commandments are spiritual.**

The Commandments are not carnal they are holy and they are righteous they could not be fulfilled by the carnal thinking or carnal intentions of mankind because he was not able to do that which is Righteous because he was a slave to sin and iniquity and his soul was imprisoned and sentenced to death for his sins.

This bondage and the nature of sin which is wickedness was conquered by Jesus Christ, he then took the keys of hell and death because he paid the penalty of death that sin required though he was without sin.

The injustice of his death for sins he was not guilty of rendered death powerless and Christ resurrected unto eternal life.

Christ now invites those who come to him humbly in obedience to the Gospel of Acts 2:38 saying, all ye who labor and are heavy laden come unto me and I will give you rest unto your souls.

How does Christ impart his victory, his death, and his resurrection unto us that we may become partakers also of the wonderful gift of eternal life?

God cannot be righteous if he just winks at sin and pretends it does not exist!

God cannot say sin is acceptable because I know you.

How does Christ make us free from the curse of sin and how do we then walk worthy of Jesus Christ?

1Th 2:13

For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received [it] not [as] the word of men, but as **it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.**

Rom 8:2

For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Rom 8:7-9

Because the carnal mind [is] enmity against God: for **it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.**

So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

But ye are not in the flesh, **but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.**

Rom 8:14

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

Should we as men redeemed unto God be under a separate law from the angels of God who are Righteous and dwell within the Righteousness that is Manifest of the “Laws and Commandments of God in his Kingdom”?

Did not Jesus pray and reveal The Lord’s prayer?

Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

Matt. 6:10

The fallen angel rebelled and brought the curse of sin to the world. This angel and the sin or iniquity which came from within him is still governed by the authority of God’s Righteous Law and the Judgments that God’s laws perpetuate.

Man will suffer the same consequences for sin as the angels who abandoned the **Commandments which are the Kingdom Laws of God.**

These angels about 1/3 of them left their first estate of Righteousness and followed Lucifer's rebellion invoking God's law which judges "sin" or "disobedience". Lucifer leads the rebellion of mankind against the One True God the Creator of Heaven and earth through deception, rebellion, and lies.

How much more is this deception able to overcome a mere man that is so earthly and carnal in his mind and his ability to approach God?

Man in his carnal mind cannot understand the Spiritual Laws and Commandments that govern the "Kingdom of God". **They that are in the flesh cannot please God!**

Romans Chapter 6 & 7

Rom 6:14

For **sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.**

Adam once walked in the Grace of God being graced with the Righteousness of God he glorified God in his body.

Adam was made in the Image and Likeness of God created in God's Righteousness he manifest the Grace of God which is the Spirit of Righteousness, the Spirit of God in sinless flesh.

Gen 6:3

And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also [is] flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.

All who through, disdain, ignorance or those who simply refuse to subjugate themselves to being born again, cannot taste nor become a partaker of God's Grace!

God's **Grace** is **inherited through the adoption of the Spirit**, not of man, nor the persuasion of man, but it is the Witness and the Testimony of the spirit of Christ in the born again believer.

The Testimony of Jesus Christ in those who are converted being born again from heaven **is the Word of God** and **the Righteousness of God!**

Rom 7:9

For **I was alive** without the law once: but **when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died.**

Paul is trying to convey an important point here that those who are not born again can neither experience, nor hardly understand.

According to Paul's teaching it is because he is dead spiritually that he cannot recognize his need to repent and put to death the old sin man or sin nature which was once very much alive in him.

Paul said **I was alive** my flesh nature was in full control I was blind to sin and I was satisfying the desires of my flesh which was ruling my spirit, my body and my mind.

When the commandment came which is the Righteous law of God I heard the demand of the Law and I understood my failure because of my sins and the penalty and awareness **my sins revived** and convicted me of my error and **revealed to me my impending death.**

It was conviction for sins against the Righteous laws of God, "The Ten Commandments" that brought Paul the murderer to repentance.

Paul was baptized into the watery grave of Jesus Christ becoming obedient to Christ's death, through the Gospel, the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The Gospel of Jesus Christ put the old man Saul the sinner to death. And the Spirit of Life the Spirit of Jesus Christ came upon Saul who became Paul when he was born again from above.

The new man Paul, a new creation is now the Righteousness of the Law which is the Spirit of Jesus Christ, God's Grace or the Holy ghost now resided inside Paul who is no longer a murderer but is now a son of God.

Rom 7:7

What shall we say then? **[Is] the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet.**

The conviction of God's Word, the Gospel of the Kingdom, and God's Commandments brought me to repentance through Jesus Christ and **the old flesh man died that I might live as an over comer of sin unto God in the Spirit of Grace being born again from above!**

It was the commandment of God that awoke Paul and revealed his spiritual condition and his present relationship within the context of God's Righteous Law the **Ten Commandments**. This forced Paul to choose his master whether to be a slave to sin, or an heir of Righteousness with Jesus Christ.

Christ is now the sum total of the *Sacrificial Law* we must be accepted of Him to escape judgment for our sins. The Spirit within us will bear witness of Christ in our life, or that of fallen man, which is the rebellious nature of the fallen angel. One who professes to be joined to Christ will not violate God's *Moral Laws of the Kingdom*, and voluntarily bring themselves under the power of Judgment for their sins, unless they are deceived by the devil, given to another gospel then that of Christ and the Apostles, or are babes without understanding of God's plan of Salvation.

Heb 5:12-14

For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.

For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe.

But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, [even] those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

The Law of sin genders to death and brings a Judgment by *Judicial Law* upon all who commit violence against God's *Moral laws* and commandments, and there were also *Ceremonial Laws* that redeem or stay the execution of judgment or death for the repentant victims by postponing man's judgment of death and offering a substitute offering in his place.

Christ is now the only substitute offering for sin. **If we are loyally espoused to Christ being joined to Him by the indwelling spirit of God,** then the penalty for sin Christ paid at Calvary will be counted as payment for our sins also. Christ is the sum total of the *Judiciary Law* all judgment is committed unto Him.

The Law of Sin which required the penalty of death was invoked by the fallen Angel when he managed through temptation to corrupt the heart and mind of mankind causing man to rebel against God in the Garden of Eden. We know and have assurance that the *Moral Laws* were already in existence in God's government on earth at the completion of creation and in the heavenly realms. Judicial Law required Lucifer be cast down because he violated the *Moral law of God's Kingdom* usurping God's Word and Authority.

Being an immortal Angel his destruction will not come till the final judgment at the conclusion of God's plan for man's redemption. Thus while he has a little time he went about to lead away God's creation unto himself.

God has had rules, moral values and instruction to live by in place ever since the creation of the earth in Genesis, and He placed mankind over the management of it. Adam and Eve were instructed how to please God and live within their earthly realm in the Garden. Adam and Eve were forewarned of the *Judicial Law* of God which would invoke the consequence of disobedience and sin.

It was knowledge from Lucifer an old self appointed theologian, who started the rebellion that convinced Eve then Adam that they were as able as God to make choices about their future and the destiny of the world.

As Lucifer began to denigrate the Law of God and twist the Word of God that came to Adam and Eve he caused them to doubt, to stumble then came the irreversible fall of all mankind.

Lucifer's old slight of hand trick worked then, just as it is working today, in the hearts and lives of many who have been duped as Eve was to look upon God's law as an evil thing. Many today blame God for man's physical illnesses and fallen conditions rather than recognizing man's willingness to subjugate their lives to Lucifer and affirm the contract of death and deception of the devil, which mankind signed his rights to life off on in the Garden of Eden.

Paul said there is the (Law of sin unto death) This law existed in the beginning of creation as God warned man not to sin, or he would come under the penalty of the Law which had no power over man in his innocence until man came under the curse of sin introduced to mankind by Lucifer only then did death and the spirit of disobedience begin to overcome mankind. The law is still working in the flesh of sinners and Christians alike because death is still certain for our bodies. Sin is governed by law. Death of the body and spirit is certain for the unrepentant sinner. The nature of sin is the nature of the fallen angel every person is continually tempted by that nature to turn away from God and grace to entertain the sin nature and satisfy the flesh, to magnify oneself with pride, greed, immorality, jealousy and such things that deny a Christ like nature.

God wrote the Ten Commandments with his own finger.

They were written that man would know what offended the Kingdom of God and those things which bring man under the curse of sin unto death.

Paul also spoke of the Law of Moses which governed the temple sacrifices, the camp and the people. (Some examples are.)

law of the burnt offering

law of the meat offering

law of the sin offering

law of the trespass

law of the sacrifice

law of the beasts, and of the fowl

law of the leper

law of him that hath an issue

law of jealousies

law of the Nazarite

law for him that sinneth through ignorance

Duet 31:26

Take this book of the **law**, and put it in the side of the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, that it may be there for a witness against thee.

Paul said where there is no law (Judgment) there is no sin. That's why it is so important for the Christian to be free from the curse of sin. The Law of Moses was not intent only to punish but to reveal what man in his waywardness from God had forgotten, revealing sin that the people might know if they had committed a sin against God. If a person had committed sin it also revealed how to escape the penalty of sin, which is death, by offering a substitute, and God accepted the life of a beast in the place of fallen man.

God himself prepared the first substitute offering for Adam and Eve when they were taken by sin, and God clothed them with the skin of the sacrifice. It was only a temporary covering which would need to be replaced again and again.

Man did not receive forgiveness for his sin it was simply a work of Grace by faith on the part of fallen man that he might have his true penalty delayed for a time, a temporary stay of judgment until the messiah Jesus Christ would come and make restitution for all who died in faith in Grace being obedience to God's Word, and His Laws and Commandment to repent.

The Gospel is declared in the Old Testament as early as Genesis 3:15. However the Gospel message of the promise given Abraham by God was demonstrated by his faith in God's Word by the works of Abraham. Abraham was looking forward to a promise of redemption just as many are today when they come in faith to Jesus Christ and repent of their sins. **The Gospel message of the Old Testament and the prophets was looking forward to the coming messiah who would take away the sting of death and free man from the curse of sin.**

Jesus became our substitute offering. The temple work is done forever, no more sacrifices for sin. More than that we are joined to Christ into one Spirit and because we are one body with Christ and He in us we no longer owe the debt for our sin because Christ who we are espoused to has already paid the debt.

The old curse of sin we were bound to, is no longer married to us, because we have forsaken our sins by obedience to the Gospel and are now espoused to Christ. That debt will be erased forever at the marriage of Christ and his body the Church.

The Law of Sin and death still exists but has no power as long as we lead a chaste lifestyle resisting sin and we remain loyally espoused to Jesus Christ.

We are still capable of being tempted by Sin, and conceiving sin and denying the blood of God who came to save us, thereby coming through

un-repentance under the curse of death by committing lawless deeds such as:

Disobedience (to God's Word, Adam and eve simply disobeyed and ate what was forbidden by God)

Murder

Adultery

Envy

Pride

Strife

Lasciviousness

Covetousness

Stealing

Heresy

Idolatry

False Witness

Blasphemy

Usurping God's Word and authority

And much more.....

We are espoused to Christ when we are obedient to the call to repentance, and obey the Gospel. We're now waiting for that day the groom will appear to receive the members of Christ's body the Church who are espoused to Him.

The Bible say's we can only be espoused to one husband that is Christ, or the sin nature of disobedience and wickedness.

If we are still espoused to sin and the wickedness of disobedience, if we are found to be adulterers at Christ's coming, we will be rejected by Christ because we continue to be adulterers loving sin for a season more then God.

Where there is no law there is no sin! The Law of God has always existed, man was just in his innocence before the fall similar to a baby, and did not know how to injure his conscience and defile his body.

The fallen angel understood the laws of God and set about to use that which was good to turn man against God and God's kingdom laws, by causing man to judge God to be wrong and unfair, rather than to despise the temptations of the fallen angel who brought sin and depravity upon the human race.

God's judgment for sin and the penalty of death was not because God hated his creation but because he loved his creation. Judgment was to protect those who would seek repentance and truly wanted forgiveness from God for their struggle with sin.

God's work with sin was similar to ones love that would be shown by setting up quarantine in an outbreak of the plague. The plan was to save what could be saved and protect those who were not yet ready to die, until the immunization could be made ready to destroy the plague once and for all.

God did not put sin on mankind, Lucifer the fallen angel brought sin to man, very cunningly he tricked Eve and she became his first victim and she convinced Adam and the two were judged worthy of death.

A pre-existing law was executed through disobedience to God, which invoked death for the wages of sin, even after God warned Adam and Eve, very clearly and candidly, that the penalty was certain and the judgment was sure. Yet they took heed to the lies of the devil and ate the poison of betrayal against their creator whom they knew face to face in their Garden home.

Satan took advantage of man's limited understanding and his innocence as he still does today. He knows mankind is an emotional creature who desires selfish things to fulfill the void sin has left in the heart of fallen man.

Without the law of God no matter how crude it may have seemed at times, without the execution of the penalty for those who broke covenant with God and the shedding of the blood of innocent beasts

who bore the sins of the people, the Old Testament saints could not have rested in peace awaiting the arrival of Jesus Christ who would once and for all wipe away the record of their judgment, which had been stayed temporarily because of their obedience, and the substitute offering on the alter to hold at bay the judgment of God.

The enemy wants us to focus on how God's law effected man and offended the flesh rather than to focus on the real problem which is the nature of sin, and the spirit of disobedience that God's enemy has brought upon unrepentant and unregenerate mankind.

No matter how saved we are, there is a law in our members which reminds us every day that we have not yet been perfected in the flesh. Complete Perfection will not take place until the marriage of Christ to his bride the church or else our bodies would be redeemed now also.

However we are complete in Christ when we walk in obedience and our Salvation is sure when Christ shall appear.

Paul spoke of the law in his members, we all know about that law to some degree. I feel that law often myself it is aches, pains, muscle aches, shoulder sockets and knees wearing out. All these things are due to the judgment of sin, these are tell, tell, signs and a witness to the record God gave when he warned man that sin would bring death and destruction upon mankind.

Sin is just that way, the born again child of God doesn't want the consequences of it, but sin and many of the consequences of sin continue to taunt us, remind us, and tempt us until the ultimate victory when we pass from this life or Christ returns for His Church.

The law made sure that God's plan had someone to rescue when Christ would come and He would bring redemption to man by His death on the cross at Calvary. You might say the law, *The Ceremonial, Judicial and Moral Law*, walked the human race (those who would obey God) down the corridor through time to the place of opportunity when Christ would pay the penalty for our sin, remove the scourge of sin, expunge our record and stay our execution for those sins. Christ at the marriage supper

celebration will remove the penalty for repentant sins completely and permanently from his espoused. Therefore the law was our school master to bring us all into espousal and marriage to Jesus Christ.

Where there is no law (judgment) there is no sin. Christians can still fall into sin. The law of sin and death is still as powerful today as it was when Eve and Adam disobeyed God. We just have an advocate now.

If we will repent and be espoused to Christ by the Gospel of Salvation, we will be joined to him in the great marriage ceremony, and the penalty that he paid for sin will be noted as paid to our account because we are joined to Him, and he to us, and we are one Spirit with Christ.

1 Cor 6:15

Know ye not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make [them] the members of an harlot? God forbid.

What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh.

But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit

Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body.

What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost [which is] in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Phil. 1:27

Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;

The Spirit of Christ indwelling true Christians will help us to honor God's *Moral Law*.

Christ is the sum total of the Moral Law!
Christ is the sum total of the Judicial Law!
Christ is the sum total of the Sacrificial Law!

Until the heart's desire has been changed on the inside, the flesh man will continue to manifest Godlessness, rebellion and disdain for the life of Christ, and the Kingdom Laws of God.

Jesus said, this about the commandments!

Mat 19:16

And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, **what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life?**

And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? [there is] none good but one, [that is], God: but **if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.**

Some do not seem to understand the Grace of God is the Spirit of God's Righteousness nor do they seem to understand the Kingdom Laws of God represent God's Righteousness.

This Righteousness within us is not our own righteousness but the Righteousness of Jesus Christ that dwells in Spirit within those who are born again. Christ reigns in the temple of God.

We are striving to walk Righteous and we are striving to be Holy not of ourselves or by our own ability but because Jesus Christ in us is Righteous and we are not our own.

John 14:12

Jesus said, "Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father."

We have been purchased by the blood of Jesus Christ we have been joined together in one Spirit with Jesus Christ therefore we also should have the same Testimony of the Righteousness of Jesus Christ.

We therefore should be a yielded vessel unto the Spirit of the Lord to learn his ways and conform to the image of Jesus Christ to become a Righteous and Holy Testimony of Jesus Christ.

There is only one way the Ten Commandments could be annulled and would not judge sin now or in the end of all things.

If the Ten Commandments are dead then God, Jesus Christ the Lawgiver would be dead and Satan would have won the war that is still raging.

God's Righteousness renders the spirit of rebellion and disobedience powerless in those who come to repentance and are born again!

If Righteousness did not rule in heaven and reign through Jesus Christ in the earth, God would no longer be in charge. Satan might now decide that unlawful behavior is now lawful? **Isn't this what some of his messengers are trying to say today to pervert the Gospel of Jesus Christ?**

If God is alive and the commandments are dead what will God use as the Law that will judge and convict the world of sins?

Liberal theories of today are nothing more or less than an anti-Christ theology implying we are magically or automatically saved by Christ without any response on our part, that there is no conviction or guilt forgoing unrepentant sins, nor any need for genuine repentance or obedience toward water baptism for the remission of sins.

According to Dr. Scripture View's theology the Gospel the Apostles preached is not true, because that would require a conscious behavioral response and an act of obedience toward fulfillment of the "Word of God" as seen in Acts Chapter two.

Dr. Scripture View erroneously interprets obedience as a mark of legalism and a damnable sin!

Dr. Scripture View also mentions his disdain for the display of the Ten Commandments he saw hanging in a Church because it reminds him that some think he should be subject to them!

One born of God should be overjoyed to see the Righteous Laws of his father's Kingdom displayed before those who may come near to them and see their sinful condition by them much like mirror reveals one disheveled in appearance while there is still time to repent, turn from sin and experience the blessedness of entering the strait gate that leads into the Kingdom of God.

Gen 3:1

Now the serpent was more subtle than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

Gen 3:2

And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden:

Gen 3:3

But of the fruit of the tree which [is] in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.

God's Righteous Laws governed a perfect Kingdom and all of Creation by God's Commands were entrusted to the knowledge and keeping of our parents in the Garden of Eden. **Thou shalt not eat of the Tree of Knowledge!**

This doctrine that all things are good to partake of, all things are accessible and expedient to me without consequence and nothing by any means shall bring me again into the bondage of sin goes against every

scripture reference concerning sin that has ever been written in the Bible from the book of Genesis to the book of Revelation!

This doctrine is the denial of God's Righteousness indwelling born again believers, and the authority of God's Kingdom Laws the Ten Commandments. This idea or theology that God's Law is abrogated is a **POISONOUS DOCTRINE!**

It is a lie from the serpent the old dragon who is non other then the fallen angel that seeks to convince and beguile the world to again believe his lies!

You can hear the Serpent hissing if you listen closely to what this lie, or theology, really seeks to destroy!

The idea that you cannot be lost if you simply confess Jesus as Lord and that is all there is to Christianity is an erroneous lie of the fallen angel!

This is **Anti-Christ, Anti-Righteous, Anti-Gospel and Anti-God Theology!**

Dr. Scripture View's Theology?

1. Believes - The Law covers everything concerning the Old Testament, *The Ceremonial Law*, *Judicial Law* and *Moral Law*.
2. Dr. Scripture View does not seem to classify the work of SIN as wickedness of disobedience being in conflict with God's LAWS and the Righteous Judgment of God. Truth finds the duty to execute judgment and justice by the "LAW of RIGHTEOUSNESS". The "Ten Commandments" reveal man's disobedience when measuring ones conformity to the image and likeness of Christ in the Kingdom of God.
3. Dr Scripture View's interpretation of grace is the same as most of the mainstream denominational interpretations of grace.
4. Many erroneously believe Grace is simply faith or the confidence within the conscience of man's mind. Grace to many is erroneously thought to be a get out of hell free pass, something I have heard, I now believe it, therefore I am now saved regardless of my sins whether I repent of them or live in them or not!
5. This is not far from secular humanistic thought where a man's destiny is determined by the power of his own mind and his ability is determined by his own will. In essence man becomes his own god by the persuasion of his thought processes he is completely independent of a creator and does not subjugate himself to the possibility of a Grand design by the Creator God or God having created a plan whereby man must subjugate himself in order to be justified from his imperfections!
6. **One cannot truly receive God's grace unless one receives the promise, the comforter, the Spirit of Righteousness which indwells the temple of this body to turn us away from sin and into deeper relationship and purpose in Christ.**

Grace is not a state of mans conscience, but **the Spirit of God indwelling. The Holy Ghost is the Spirit of Grace whereby we overcome the temptations of sin. The spirit of wickedness tempts the carnal minded flesh man to disobey and sin against God!**

God has graced you with his Spirit, if you have been born again from above!

Therefore you are not on your own to keep the Law or overcome sin, but **Jesus Christ in you now makes you whole**, completing you in Righteousness because you are one in Spirit with Christ, one body, therefore you can now worship God in the beauty of Holiness. Through the process of redemption and spiritual rebirth, God's Righteousness is being established to reign upon the earth even as it is in heaven.

Absolutely nothing is to the credit of mankind pertaining to the gift of Salvation. The gift of eternal life is offered in the form of an espousal to Jesus Christ and is offered to all who yield themselves willingly to Him partaking of His baptisms, suffering and sacrifice. One must first subjugate themselves to God's spirit then become obedient to Gospel of Christ being baptized into Christ's death, burial and resurrection as it was first preached by the twelve Apostles. (Acts 2:38)

Christ's body is free from failure and judgment because the law of sin that caused you to be cursed is not able to take ownership of those who are espoused to Christ walking in His Righteousness and in the perfect Law of Liberty. **The Law of the Spirit of Life in us, is Christ Jesus.**

Do you have the Testimony of Jesus Christ? We being joined to Christ in Spirit have liberty and freedom from the persuasions and bondage of sin, not a free pass to become a playground for sin and disobedience!

Christ makes you free from the old love, lust and desire to be in bondage to sin!

When you knowingly and purposely deny the Righteous Laws of God you deny Jesus Christ and his Righteousness.

When one willingly continues to commit sins that are unto death, and conscience no longer pleads for the soul, you have divorced yourself from the Righteousness of Christ. The consequences therefore will be for the transgressor to willingly break or abrogate the Laws of God to become guilty of sin and worthy of death without taking assessment of ones own offences toward God!

If this were not true, Adam a righteous man at birth made in the image of God could not have fallen from grace and would not have come under the curse or authority of sin!

If the Law of Righteousness has passed away, then all who seek the favor of God through obedience, being espoused to Jesus Christ by the Gospel and thereby becoming an heir to the sacrifice of Christ's redeeming blood at the marriage supper in heaven are just wasting their time.

Doesn't this sound like the same lying tongue that was speaking to Eve in the Garden of Eden? Are the commandments of God a vain evil thing? Of course not! God's commandments condemn the sinner that they may know what sin is?

If the Ten Commandments are dead or nailed to the cross then the law of Sin and Death is also dead. Nobody can be lost? Nobody need repent any longer?

Paul said, without the Law how would I know sin?

The Law reveals to us how sinful sin is! How should the Church of God Judge sin if there be no Law?

Jesus said, For Judgment I am come into the world!

How can one judge righteously those who are not under law?

Would it be fair for a German or Russian policeman to arrest you here in America for violating a law that does not apply anywhere except in his former home of Germany or Russia?

Would it be fair to have the sentence of death passed upon you under the laws of a country that didn't exist?

All of the Godhead is in Christ! Christ is Righteous and his Judgments are true.

The bible says that Christ will Judge every man! Why?

If you are a citizen in the Kingdom of God you are an alien to earthly and carnal disputations about God's Law. The Citizens of God's kingdom are ruled by God's Kingdom Laws.

Psa 2:9

Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.

Rev 2:27

And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.

Rev 12:5

And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child was caught up unto God, and [to] his throne.

Rev 19:15

And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Because the Righteousness of the Ten Commandments is fulfilled in Christ he is the perfection of Righteousness that the Ten Commandments represent and demand and all sinners will be compared to the Righteousness of Jesus Christ. All who do not measure up to the standard of Jesus Christ will be cast into everlasting darkness.

This means that man has to be born again of the Spirit, born from above. Unless man is joined to Jesus Christ spiritually he cannot be saved nor be Righteous nor be free from the Law of sin and death.

Is Christ now giving those identified as his espoused bride a get out of hell free pass so they may betray the Righteous blood of Christ who suffered for His future bride as her husband and redeemer?

Did Christ give his bride a license to commit adulteries with the father of sin and disobedience?

God forbid! If this were true God, Jesus Christ would be an adulterer also! When a husband and wife are joined they are one in body. We are one Spirit with Christ.

This attempt to make Christ a Lawbreaker and an adulterer with you to excuse you from your sin comes straight out of the devils filing cabinet under the label “damnable doctrines”. Remember man’s fall back there in the Garden of Eden?

If sin does not exist then Righteousness “The Word of God” would not judge sin or disobedience in the sinner or the righteous.

Do you know what sin is? Why do you know what sin is?

You know what sin is because sin still exists in this world and the Ten Commandments the Laws of God are still judging this world!

God has brought conviction upon every repentant sinner who has ever obeyed the Gospel to be joined to Christ thereby revealing God’s Righteousness and the need to repent. The Ten Commandments are an Everlasting Statute that will span all generations and all time! The day will come after the judgment that there will be no need to be reminded of the Laws of God, everything will be in subjection and harmony with God and sin and rebellion will not exist in God’s Kingdom.

Adam and eve didn’t know what sin is! Why?

Because there was nothing to contradict the Righteousness of the Ten Commandment Laws therefore they lived in perfection within them, they

were so pure in their perfection that being naked provoked no sinful thoughts, nor evil nature nor anything that would shame them or bring dishonor to them in the sight of God.

This question assumes you're a Spirit filled Christian who has the Holy Ghost and honors Christ with your whole heart.

Would you be ashamed at the supermarket if you were sleep walking and awoke innocently and found yourself in public inappropriately or improperly dressed standing in the frozen food isle with many shoppers standing around you whispering about your predicament?

Why?

Because sin and shame still abounds, and the Law of sin which genders to death is still judging those who violate God's Word which are his Laws of Righteousness which promote peace and decency within the human race!

If we were judged or embarrassed by inappropriate dress, being subject to a public situation though we were innocent or unaccountable for the situation in our conscience. What would provoke this guilt?

Sin!

What is Sin? If you know that sin exists then you are still under God's Righteous Law.

Some have a hard time determining what sin is because they do not understand the nature of sin or who sin's father is.

Sin's father is Lucifer. The spirit of wickedness is Lucifer the fallen angel and sin has dominion over all who dishonor God's Kingdom Laws and His plan to redeem mankind from the penalty of disobedience. Three manifestations appear in the Bible, the rebellious angel, Sin and the spirit of wickedness yet one fallen angel is at the root of this rebellion.

There are two houses that exist presently in rivalry.

1. The household of God
2. The Household of Rebellion

There are three primary manifestations of the fallen angel yet these manifestations or testimonies of his hatred against God is not recognized by many and laid to his account.

1. Lucifer the fallen angel is the father of sin.
2. Disobedience to God's Laws, are Lucifer's spiritual calling card.
3. Sin is the manifestation of Lucifer's lordship in the children of disobedience

There are three primary spiritual attacks made by this enemy.

1. Deception - The enemy appears like the real thing on the surface but his ways lead to death and destruction.
2. Lies - When he speaks he speaks of himself professing Truth to be lies and lies to be the truth.
3. Disobedience and rebellion is very often just explained away by the children of disobedience, changes to God's word and the changing of God's Laws are described as a divine mandate for man on the behalf of God.
- 4.

Dan 7:25-26

And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.

But the judgment [God's Laws of judgment, penalty and justice] shall sit, and they shall take away his dominion, to consume and to destroy it unto the end.

And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of

the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him.

The Righteous Law of God is still in force against sin invoking the penalty of death! God said, The soul that sins it shall die!

God is the same yesterday, today and forever! His Righteous Judgment of sin will abound until the root of sin and wickedness is destroyed forever!

The Law of sin and Death is a Righteous Law of God that finds its application and enforcement in the violation of any of the Ten Commandments or other righteous laws of God.

Those who place all the Law in one lump and say it has all passed away are in grave error and teach others to continue in their error to the hurt of their own souls.

These do not have a clear picture according to the scriptures about their salvation or how the Righteous Law of God still convicts them of their own sins.

The Law of sin and death will also judge them if they are not born again from above and have not subjugated themselves completely to Christ as we are informed to do in Acts 2:38

Therefore the Law Paul spoke of that the Christian is free from is not the Law of Righteousness by the Spirit which the “Ten Commandments reflect”!

If the Righteous Law has past away or is no longer in existence then breaking one or all the Ten Commandments would not invoke the “Law of sin unto death”. If the law did not condemn sin any longer that would mean all is perfect as in the creation of Adam, and we would not be ashamed of our nakedness or depravity in the presence of God!

It would then be impossible to violate any of the Ten Commandments because sin (Disobedience) would not exist anymore!

How does God convict the heart of a sinner if the Righteousness of his Law does not any longer apply and the Law of sin and death is abrogated?

Paul is speaking concerning all of the temple ceremonies, daily sacrifices, priestly rituals and Holidays that were performed in the anticipation that the Messiah would someday appear and begin his Reign.

These events were shadows of a day to come. When Christ came most of the practices were no longer practiced by the New Testament Church in anticipation of a coming messiah but are now the celebration of His reign.

There were those who rejected Christ and their testimony was antichrist because they looked for another messiah rather than Christ.

The Jews and Gentiles who continued these practices of sacrifice and commandments of men, confessed by their continuance and their living testimony that they denied that Jesus Christ had come in the flesh as the Messiah!

Christ did not annul Righteousness he came to fulfill all Righteousness. He didn't come to tell man it was OK now to yield to sin. Christ came to give us of his Spirit, with Power to overcome all manner sin.

Matt 5:18

For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

Rom 7:12

Wherefore the law [is] holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.

Phil 3:9

And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law [**We come under judgment without Christ within**], but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:

Rom 8:4

That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Col 1:27

To whom God would make known what [is] the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; **which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:**

Luk 10:19

Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Wouldn't this kind of power enable mankind to keep the righteous laws of God in his heart and example his life by God's Righteousness which is in Jesus Christ and He in us and we in him?

Some may say nobody could keep the Law as God commanded, but they may forget that God did use mortal men to come into the Holy of Holies and sprinkle the blood upon the mercy seat where the Spirit of God would come down and receive the sacrifice for the people annually. God prepared an escape of judgment for those who loved and honored Him. So great was the expectation of God for the men he appointed that if the priests were defiled by sin they would fall down dead in the holy of holies while performing their duties.

What is your Living Testimony one of Jesus Christ and his Righteousness or does your Living Testimony forgo a Lawless and blatant offender of God's Righteousness?

No body is born Righteous. What makes him righteous?

Isa. 64:6

But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

Christ in us is the keeper of the Righteous Law of God's Kingdom! Because he lives Righteously we live Righteously being born of the same Spirit of Christ the Spirit of Grace which is the Spirit of God.

Does Christ break and violate the Righteous Laws of his Kingdom? How could he be God and commit sin against His own Laws?

God forbid! Such an anti-Christ suggestion!

If Christ be in us we will not willingly rebel either!

Those who resist Obedience to God and the Ten Commandments also resist Christ and the indwelling Spirit of Christ!

One who does not keep the “Ten Commandments” has not truly yielded completely to the Righteousness of Jesus Christ because God himself honors and keeps his own Righteous Laws!

Jesus Christ is the fulfillment of the Righteous Law!

Jesus Christ has kept the 7th day of rest which he blessed and sanctified to his own honor since he created the Worlds!

Gen 2:3

And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made.

Does Jesus Christ really dwell within your temple are you in total subjugation to the will of Jesus Christ? IS Jesus Christ truly your Lord and Savior today?

Are you allowing the Spirit of God to lead you into the deeper depths of living water by fulfilling all Righteousness as Christ himself does and by his example has shown us to do?

Jesus Christ the Messiah has come in the flesh to give those who are judged and repent the Holy Ghost power to overcome this flesh to live in Righteousness and to glorify Him in Holiness?

Does not the 4th commandment glorify God for the wonders he has created and the Salvation of man that he has made possible and has brought to pass in the face of impossibility and chaos?

Romans 1:18, 21-32

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness;

Because that, when they knew God, they glorified [him] not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools,

And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.

Wherefore **God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves:**

Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.

For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature:

And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet.

And even as they did not like to retain God in [their] knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;

Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers,

Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents,

Without understanding, covenantbreakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful:

Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them

Romans 1:28

And even as they did not like to retain God in [their] knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;

What was that knowledge they did not like to retain? the Righteous "Law of God".

Romans 1:32

Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.

How did they know the Judgment of God?

Breaking the Commandments of God brings judgment. If the Commandments are gone then judgment and condemnation is gone also!

Are we back in the Garden of Eden yet?

Christ is the Righteousness of God, The Word of God the Ten Commandments are manifest in him and he in us!

Where are the fruits of Christ's Righteousness if Christ be in us?

We do not by our own merit, gain favor of God except we comply and obey God as the Spirit of Jesus Christ which is the Holy Ghost gives us the ability!

By Christ, that is the Holy Ghost within us, we made perfect even as he is perfect!

The Law, the Ten Commandments are kept perfectly in Christ!

Christ is the Word of God! Christ is the Law of God!

Christ baptizes us into one Spirit with him that we may worship in Spirit and in Truth.

If we purposely break God's Laws any one of them is our Testimony and Witness of Jesus Christ True?

NO! NO! A Thousand Times NO!

Rev 6:9

And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were **slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:**

And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, **dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?**

We would be a false witness of Christ's Righteousness if we were to knowingly and willingly betray the Righteousness of God's Law on purpose!

We must realize that we are being drawn to a more perfect existence, to a higher Law as the body of Christ.

Eph 4:13-15

Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive;

But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:

The anti-Christ has sought to kill and destroy those who keep the Commandments of God and the Testimony of Jesus Christ!

1Jo 3:24

And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

1Jo 5:2-4

By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.

For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and **this is the victory that overcometh the world, [even] our faith.**

Rev 12:17

And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

Rev 14:12

Here is the patience of the saints: here [are] they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

Rev 13:10

He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints.

He that condemns men to the Death by deception and apostasy through perverting, distorting or turning away from the Word of God shall be judged worthy of death by the Righteous Law and Commandments of God. *Ref Jer 15:2*

Rev 22:14

Blessed [are] they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

Rev 22:21

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ [be] with you all. Amen.

The Spirit of our Lord Jesus Christ [be] with you All. Amen

Dr. Scripture View believes erroneously one of the following statements if not all of them?

1. Dr. Scripture View believes he has achieved that which we all long for, which is to be in the Kingdom of God completely restored sitting in the presence of God after the judgment of all the world is past and all is summed up and finished in a state of perfection and is innocent as Adam and Eve were in the garden of Eden, having received his glorious body, not knowing sin because sin does not exist any longer in heaven or the earth.
2. Dr. Scripture View's comments have no legitimate basis in God's Word or to those who have been born from above! However it is a common argument from those who deny the indwelling of the Spirit of God and speak of the rebirth process as passive and uneventful to Christian believers.
3. One who is not born again is unskilled in the Word and may unknowingly be aiding the enemy, not being commissioned by God to speak concerning God's Word in this area of scripture. This argument is false coming from the perspective of one that has no understanding of the relationship of Christ and his work through the Gospel. It is likely that one believing this erroneous theology has been deceived to believe that Christ fulfilled everything magically turning sin into something that is now acceptable to God, and that nobody can now be lost regardless of their actions which oppose faith, morality or obedience or even those who may worship other gods!

We Believe the Scriptures speak the following principles to the Christian

1. Without the Law of God being in force that is the Ten Commandments how would we know what sin is?
2. Sin brings man under judgment because the Law of Righteousness compels mankind to resist sin and keep the Commandments of God that he might desire to have a new eternal life of Righteousness with Jesus Christ!
3. Would Christ be joined together in one Spirit with an unrepentant or unconverted harlot? No! Why not?

One must be judged before they can be convicted and brought to a place of repentance. Then they may after repentance be Sanctified and Justified.

How can God Judge when there is no Law against sin and transgression?

If one is not condemned by the **Laws of God's Righteousness** the **"Ten Commandments"** then they cannot come to repentance.

The only way a person would not be condemned by the Ten Commandments is:

1. If they resist them, have been deceived, are reprobate, or misinformed having their conscience seared by false teachings or explanations of men.
2. If one is a born again Christian they will begin to keep the Righteousness of God's Law more perfectly after coming to the knowledge of Jesus Christ and Christ is indwelling the temple!

3. Many of those opposed to God's Righteous Laws will writhe and scream and slander screaming legalism, legalism until the day of the great white throne judgment unless per adventure God should enlighten them through the Spirit of Truth, by which all Christians must be born again from above; to become a Temple of the living God that the Spirit of Jesus Christ may dwell in them to freely testify of God's Righteousness?

Then ye shall also walk even as our Savior and Creator, Jesus Christ, who sanctified and blessed the 7th Day to his Honor and continues to walk therein!

Without they obey the Gospel they cannot be joined to Christ in his death or his resurrection!

These two Testimonies and Witnesses (Christ death and resurrection) make possible the translation of sinners from death into a life of Righteousness of Joy and Peace in the Kingdom of God

4. Christ does not make sin OK, he takes away the inherited sins of Adam and gives the convert authority to overcome his present world and the temptation of sin is overcome by the Spirit of Jesus Christ which is the Spirit of Grace!
5. Christ paid the penalty for sin already. When we have been obedient to the Gospel of Acts 2:38 and have been spiritually reborn from above, then we are a partaker of the Spirit of Grace, we have become one with Jesus Christ through espousal to Him.
6. Christ cannot be judged under the penalty of death for sin because the debt has already been paid by Christ our savior with whom we are now espoused to be married being joined into one Spirit. Because Jesus Christ is Righteous and Holy we also stand with him in Holiness and Obedience. Having been cleansed and sanctified by Christ's blood and his Spirit!

7. We cannot be judged unless we sin a sin that is unto death. Therefore we would then have done despite to the blood of Jesus Christ trampling underfoot his mercy and sacrifice. There would remain no more forgiveness for sins if we willfully and continually or purposely break the Righteous Law of God after we receive knowledge of our sins.

8. As long as Christians know what sin is, or there is a debate about what sin is then we are living in a world where the Law of God continues to judge us everyone both sinners and saints.

9. Everyone in the world will be judged by God's Law! It is the Law of God that will judge all of mankind in the final hour of Judgment.

10. Would it be fair for a Righteous God to judge mankind by something that did not exist to him or that man was never aware of?

11. What compels a murderer to run when he is being sought after? Is it not the fear of Judgment?

12. What compels a sinner to repent is it not Judgment? Is not Judgment and conviction of sin the work of the Righteous Laws of God in the heart of mankind?

13. Doeth not the Goodness and the Mercy of God leadeth thee to repentance?

God revealed his goodness to Moses revealing his Righteous laws and expectations to those whom God Loves with an everlasting love. It was God's mercy that was revealed to us through the suffering and death of Jesus Christ.

We are not able of ourselves to escape the eternal judgments for sins past or present. Through Christ we can now be free from sins power and have the liberty to live in the Righteous Kingdom of God because we can be forgiven, and Sanctified by the blood of Jesus Christ and

joined in espousal to Christ by the Spirit of Jesus Christ. We are now adopted as sons and daughters of God washed, cleansed, sanctified and set aside for God's purpose.

Rom 8:15-17

For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with [him], that we may be also glorified together.

Has God shown us all this to have us repeat the same error that Adam and Eve committed when they broke the Kingdom Laws of God in the beginning when they were created perfect?

Christ warned us everyone of the day that is to come a day of sorrow and the day of regret.

Many will enter judgment believing they were ready but Christ said, "Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? And in thy name have cast out devils? And in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity."

Are you giving Honor to Him who bestows Honor?

Are you Giving Glory to Him who is our Glory and provides for us in a measure that is exceedingly and abundantly above all that we could ask or think?

Are you allowing Jesus Christ in you, the Creator of Heaven and earth to Testify of his Righteousness in your life?

Are you humble obedient and in subjugation to God and the Righteous Laws of God which he has made and created for his Kingdom and His glory?

Do the Kingdom Laws of God reign within the temple of God?

Ye are the temple of God if it be that the Spirit of Christ dwell in you?

Luk 17:20-21

And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, he answered them and said, **The kingdom of God cometh not with observation:**

Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, **behold, the kingdom of God is within you.**

Isa 66:22-24

For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain.

And it shall come to pass, [that] from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the LORD.

And they shall go forth, and look upon the carcasses of the men that have transgressed against me: for their worm shall not die, neither shall their fire be quenched; and they shall be an abhorring unto all flesh

Amo 5:13

Therefore the prudent shall keep silence in that time; for it [is] an evil time.

Amo 5:15

Hate the evil, and love the good, and establish judgment in the gate: it may be that the LORD God of hosts will be gracious unto the remnant of Joseph.

Amo 5:18-20

Woe unto you that desire the day of the LORD! to what end [is] it for you? the day of the LORD [is] darkness, and not light.

As if a man did flee from a lion, and a bear met him; or went into the house, and leaned his hand on the wall, and a serpent bit him.

[Shall] not the day of the LORD [be] darkness, and not light? even very dark, and no brightness in it?

Rev 13:10

He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints.

Rev 14:12

Here is the patience of the saints: here [are] they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

The Blood of Jesus Christ expunges the inherited sins of our fathers beginning with Adam and also the sins we have given ourselves too during our lives when we obey the Gospel as we are admonished to do in the book of Acts chapter 2:37-38

When we are joined in one Spirit with Jesus Christ we are then empowered by God to overcome all the powers and persuasions of the enemy of our souls. We should then be a Living Testimony of our Lord, Jesus Christ who dwells within the temple of God of which the Born again believer has then become.

Because the Spirit of Jesus Christ dwells within the Christian who is born again from above, the born again Christian should walk in the Righteous Laws of God, because the Righteousness of Jesus Christ then dwells within the temple of those who are redeemed by Christ's acceptance of us.

"Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets ..." (Matthew 5:17)

"I have kept my Father's commandments," He said (John 15:10)

Mar 2:27-28

And he said unto them, the Sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:

Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath

Lord – *meaning*

1: one having power and authority over others: **a: a ruler by hereditary right or preeminence to whom service and obedience are due** **b:** one of whom a fee or estate is held in feudal tenure **c:** an owner of land or other real property **d***obsolete*
: the male head of a household

Note, The sabbath day are days of the Son of man; he is the Lord of the day, and to his honour it must be observed; by him God made the worlds, and so it was by him that the sabbath was first instituted; by him God gave the law at mount Sinai, and so **the fourth commandment was his law;**

Mathew Henry's - Commentary

Ecc 12:13

Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this [is] the whole [duty] of man

Jhn 14:15-18

If ye love me, keep my commandments.

And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

[Even] the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you

1Jo 5:3

For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

1Jo 5:20

And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, [even] in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

Psa 119:160

Thy word [is] true [from] the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments [endureth] for ever.

Once again the celebrations have begun in the Great Revival of Anti-Christ. The devil as in former days of old has taken advantage of mankind and man's reckless disregard for the "Righteous Laws" of God, especially in relation to the Sabbath day.

Jam 2:10

For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one [point], he is guilty of all.

James said, **the Christian who abides in Jesus Christ is not under Law but is judged by the Law when he becomes a transgressor of the Law!**

A Christian who abides in Jesus Christ is to abide by the Righteousness of the Spirit of Truth and he cannot sin if he is obedient to the Righteous Laws of God.

No man can keep the Commandments of God except by Jesus Christ who lives and dwells within those who have been born from above.

If any man says he is in Christ and Christ is in him and he does not love and keep the Righteous Laws of God he testifies falsely of Jesus

Christ, by bearing a false witness that Jesus Christ is a liar and a Lawbreaker therefore not Righteous but profaned!

Therefore he has broken the following Ten Commandments.

1. Thou shall have no other Gods – Sin is his master
2. Make no idols – worshiping the idol of man’s religion & Theology
3. Do not misuse Gods Name – A false witness to the Truth in Christ
4. Keep the Sabbath Holy – Failing to glorify the Lord of Sabbath
5. Honor Father and Mother – Denying God the Father and Son
6. Do not commit Murder – Murdering the souls of others with lies
7. Do not commit adultery – Breaking God’s marriage covenant
8. Do not Steal – Man stealers - taking stealing God’s authority
9. Do not Lie – Falsely representing Jesus Christ, God as a Lawbreaker
10. Do not Covet – Desiring to posses God’s Righteousness that it may be profaned to become blasphemy, an emblem and an ensign to offend the “Righteous Laws of God’s Kingdom” the Ten Commandments!

A Christian who is offended by the Word of God and God’s Commandments is offended at God and the Righteous Judgment of God!

Man by his own knowledge, understanding, wisdom and authority has usurped God’s authority by replacing the “Ten Commandments” the “Kingdom Laws” of God with human traditions especially by substituting Sunday for the Sabbath. Today many have "made the commandments of God of no effect by [their] tradition" (Matthew 15:6)

It would be far better that a man or woman should stand questioned by God for their confidence in the “Righteousness of God’s Word” the “Ten Commandment Laws” then to be questioned of God for neglecting or despising God’s Righteousness being convinced of those who are outside of God’s Word and God’s Kingdom to obey the unrighteous and unholy theologies of men who have profaned and usurped the Righteous Law’s of God’s Kingdom!

1Jo 2:3-6

And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.

He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him.

He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.

Rev 2:1-7

Unto the angel of the church of Ephesus write; These things saith he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks;

I know thy works, and thy labour, and thy patience, and how thou canst not bear them which are evil: and thou hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and hast found them liars:

And hast borne, and hast patience, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted.

Nevertheless I have [somewhat] against thee, because thou hast left thy first love.

Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.

But this thou hast, that thou hatest the deeds of the Nicolaitans, (Lawless) which I also hate.

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

Rev 2:8-11

And unto the angel of the church in Smyrna write; These things saith the first and the last, which was dead, and is alive;

I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich) and [I know] the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but [are] the synagogue of Satan.

Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast [some] of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.

Rev 2:12-17

And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write; These things saith he which hath the sharp sword with two edges;

I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, [even] where Satan's seat [is]: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas [was] my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth.

But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a

stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.

So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, (Lawless) which thing I hate.

Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth.

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth [it].

Rev 2:18-29

And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet [are] like fine brass;

I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last [to be] more than the first.

Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.

Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds.

And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden.

But that which ye have [already] hold fast till I come.

And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

And he shall rule them with a rod of iron (The Righteous Law of God); as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.

And I will give him the morning star.

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

Rev 3:1-6

And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.

Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works perfect before God.

Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee.

Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with me in white: for they are worthy.

He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

Rev 3:7-13

And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;

I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.

Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not (Lawless), but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.

Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.

Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, [which is] new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and [I will write upon him] my new name.

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

Rev 3:14-22

And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God; (The Word)

I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.

So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked: (Hath not on a wedding garment to be prepared for the Groom, Jesus Christ)

I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, (**Righteousness and Holiness**) that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and [that] the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, (**Humble thyself to hear Truth**) that thou mayest see.

As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.

Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

The Early church influences such as Iranaeus, identified the Nicolaitans in his treatise "Against Heresies" in the second century as they who are an "offshoot of the knowledge which is falsely so-called," mentioning that they "**lead lives of unrestrained indulgence.**"

These letters are open to all until the consummation of all things. There is no contradiction of the Truths they contain. These are in perfect keeping with the Gospels and the "New Testament letters" such as the "Book of Acts." Any contradiction to be found must be dealt with in the understanding or theology of the reader. Man often errors in his understanding for God's Word is without error.
